

Edmund C. Snodgrass, a fifth generation farmer and nurseryman, is president and founder of Emory Knoll Farms, Inc. and Green Roof Plants, North America's first nursery specializing in green roof plants and horticultural consulting.

Since its inception, Emory Knoll Farms has supplied plants for over 400 green roof projects throughout the United States and Canada. Edmund collaborates on green roof research with academic institutions including Penn State University, North Carolina State University and Michigan State University, and he advises botanic gardens, including the Singapore Botanic Garden and the U.S. Botanic Garden, on green roof installations.

A popular speaker and published author, Edmund lectures widely at universities and regional, national and international conferences and has been featured in *The New York Times* and on the Sundance Channel's Ecobiz documentary series, among others.



Edmund is the co-author of *Green Roof Plants: A Resource and Plant Guide* (Timber Press, 2006) and *The Green Roof Manual: Define, Design, Install, Maintain* (Timber Press 2010).
